PRIVACY AND SECURITY POLICY

Kudo is committed to safeguarding the privacy and security of the personal information entrusted to it by its clients, prospective clients, website visitors, and business partners. We recognise the importance of protecting personal data and are dedicated to handling such information in a lawful, fair, transparent, and secure manner. This Privacy Policy explains how Kudo collects, uses, stores, discloses, and protects personal information obtained through the use of our website, products, and services.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

This Privacy Notice applies to the data processing activities carried out by Kudo Trade (Mauritius) Ltd who acts as a Data Controller of your personal information. Kudo Trade (Mauritius) Ltd ("we", "us", "Kudo") is a business authorised and regulated by the Financial Services Commission of Mauritius under license number GB24203599, with registered address 6 St Denis Street, 1st Floor, River Court, Port Louis, Mauritius.

2. WHAT INFORMATION DOES KUDO OBTAIN?

The personal information collected by Kudo depends on the nature of your relationship and interactions with us, the services you use, and the products you apply for or enquire about. The categories of personal data we may collect include the following:

Identification and Contact Information: This includes your full name, residential or postal address, email address, telephone number, and other relevant contact details.

Personal and Demographic Information: We may collect information such as your date of birth, place of birth, nationality, gender, country of residence, and language preferences.

Location Information: In certain circumstances, Kudo may collect approximate geographic location data derived from your IP address or device information when you access our website, platforms, or services.



Employment and Professional Information: We may collect information relating to your occupation, employer, employment status, professional background, and source of wealth or income.

Identification Documents: To comply with legal and regulatory obligations, Kudo may collect copies of government-issued identification documents, including passports, national identity cards, driving licenses, or other acceptable identification documents containing photographs.

Financial Information: We may collect financial details including income, bank account details, trading records, financial statements, and other information required for regulatory, compliance, and account verification purposes.

Trading and Transaction Information: Kudo maintains records relating to transactions, trading activity, investment preferences, and the performance of products and services accessed through our platforms.

Account Access and Security Information: We may collect login credentials, passwords, password recovery information, and other authentication-related details necessary for account security and access management.

Communications and Correspondence: Kudo may record, monitor, and retain communications between you and us, including telephone calls, emails, chat messages, instructions, and other electronic communications relating to enquiries, transactions, customer support, or trading activities. This may include communications intended to result in the placement or execution of orders, irrespective of whether such transactions are completed.

We may also collect and retain documents, forms, correspondence, feedback, reviews, support requests, and other information voluntarily submitted by you through our website, client portal, email communications, or other communication channels.



Personal information is generally collected directly from you when you apply for an account, complete application forms, use our services, subscribe to updates, participate in promotions, contact customer support, or otherwise communicate with Kudo.

Kudo may also automatically collect certain information through your use of our website, applications, and online platforms, including cookies and similar tracking technologies. This may include information relating to device usage, browser type, IP address, browsing behaviour, and pages visited on our website. Cookies help enhance functionality, improve user experience, and support security and analytical functions. Further information regarding the use of cookies can be found in the Cookie Policy.

You may choose not to provide certain personal information requested by Kudo. However, where such information is necessary for us to provide products or services, comply with legal obligations, or verify your identity, we may be unable to establish or maintain a business relationship with you or provide the requested services.

3. HOW WILL WE USE YOUR INFORMATION?

We may use such information for any one or more of the following purposes to:

- Provide the services that you have requested, including processing transactions.
- Confirm your identity.
- Maintain your personal profile; to manage your account.
- Contact you when necessary or appropriate in relation to the services provided to you.
- Keep you updated whilst you are a customer in relation to matters such as contracts you have traded and activities of Kudo.
- Manage and administer the products and services provided to you.
- Provide you with information regarding the products and services offered by Kudo; to develop an understanding of the products and services that you may be interested in obtaining from Kudo.
- Provide you with information or opportunities that we believe may be relevant to you.
- tailor the website or other service we provide to you to your needs and interests;
- create anonymized statistical data.



By agreeing to our Terms and Conditions, you consent to the collection, use, processing, and disclosure of your personal data as described in this Privacy Policy and in accordance with the applicable laws of Mauritius. Where it is necessary to transfer your personal data outside the Republic of Mauritius, Privacy Policy (Mauritius) v1.0 2026 Kudo will ensure that such transfers are carried out in accordance with the Mauritius Data Protection Act 2017. Your personal data may be transferred to and processed in Cyprus, the European Economic Area, the United Kingdom, and other jurisdictions where our third-party service providers operate, including providers of identity verification, payment processing, cloud infrastructure, customer support, and communication services. Transfers will only take place where the destination country provides an adequate level of data protection, or where appropriate safeguards are in place, such as standard contractual clauses or equivalent measures approved under applicable law. Details of the safeguards applicable to any specific transfer are available on request by contacting us.

4. WHO MAY WE DISCLOSE YOUR INFORMATION TO?

Your personal data will be treated as strictly confidential. Where necessary and only to the extent required for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, we may share your personal information with:

- Kudo Systems Ltd, Cyprus with registration number HE 462202, acts as a third-party payment facilitator and payment services provider to Kudo Trade (Mauritius) Ltd and other companies within the Kudo Group.
- Kudo engages Sumsub as a third-party identity verification provider to carry out KYC and electronic verification checks on its behalf. Personal data processed by Sumsub, including identification documents and photographs, is handled solely for verification purposes under contractual safeguards. For further information, refer to Sumsub's privacy policy at sumsub.com.
- Other third-party service providers, vendors, and professional advisers engaged by us to support our business operations, including services such as administration, technology support, outsourcing, compliance, legal, regulatory, financial, insurance, and other professional or operational functions, where access to personal data is necessary for the performance of such services
- Introducing brokers with whom we maintain a mutual contractual relationship



- Any person or entity authorised by you to receive such information

We may also disclose personal data where it is strictly necessary and mandated under applicable law to:

- Courts, tribunals, law enforcement agencies, regulatory authorities, and other governmental or competent bodies, or in response to valid legal requests, legal obligations, or regulatory requirements, including for investigations, compliance, or reporting purposes.

5. RETENTION PERIOD OR CRITERIA USED TO DETERMINE THE RETENTION PERIOD

Kudo retains personal data for as long as necessary to provide you or the institution you represent with the products and services, and/or for other essential purposes for which data was collected, depending on the legal basis for which that data was obtained and whether we are under any additional legal or regulatory obligations to retain your personal information. Because these needs can vary different data types in the context of different legal and regulatory requirements, actual retention periods can vary.

6. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You have the following rights, in certain circumstances, in relation to your personal information:

- Right to be informed about the data processing activities undertaken by us, this information is provided in this Privacy Notice.
- Right to access your personal information. Privacy Policy (Mauritius) v1.0 2026
- Right to rectify your personal information.
- Right to request that your personal information is erased. Subject to any retention limits, we are required to comply with applicable laws and regulations.
- Right to restrict the use of your personal information.
- Right to data portability (in certain specific circumstances).
- Right to object to the processing of your personal information.
